- Take 1<sup>st</sup> right while still on exit ramp
  - At the Yield sign, facing Chuck E Cheese, turn right onto Burning Tree Road (frontage road)
  - Go approximately 1/3 mile; turn left into Center Point onto Center Point Road
- Take immediate left; the SCHA headquarters (light tan, 1 story building) and parking will be on the left

### From Greenville/Spartanburg:

Take I-26 East (toward Columbia)  
Take Exit 106, St Andrews Road, and turn left onto St. Andrews Road

Cross the bridge

Take a right at the first traffic signal onto Burning Tree Road (frontage road)

Go approximately 1/2 mile; turn left into Center Point onto Center Point Road

Take immediate left; the SCHA headquarters (light tan, 1 story building) and parking will be on the left

### From Florence:

- Take I-20 West to I-26 West toward Spartanburg
  - Take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit -106B
  - Take 1<sup>st</sup> right while still on exit ramp
  - At the Yield sign, facing Chuck E Cheese, turn right onto Burning Tree Road (frontage road)
  - Go approximately 1/3 mile, turn left into Center Point onto Center Point Road
- Take an immediate left, the SCHA headquarters (light tan, 1 story building) and parking will be on the left
