#### **Objectives:**

- 1. Describe process for development of a nursing specialty scope and standards of practice.
- 2. Examine emerging trends in faith community nursing professional practice.
- 3. Discuss ways to incorporate selected competencies associated with standards of professional practice into a faith community nursing practice.

### **Description of program:**

Faith community nursing is a nursing specialty that focuses on the intentional care of the spirit, the promotion of an integrative model of health, and the prevention and minimization of illness within the context of a faith community.

The *Faith Community Scope and Standards of Practice, third edition*, builds on what is expected of all registered nurses, specifying the "who, what, where, why, and how" of a faith community nursing practice. The standards – six standards of practice and eleven standards of professional performance – and their competencies are those by which all RNs in faith community nursing are held accountable for their practice.

This workshop will examine how nursing specialty standards of practice are developed and brought into use in clinical practice. It will examine the emerging trends that are influencing faith community nursing, health care, and the nursing profession and describe competencies associated with evaluation of professional practice.
